We have been developing small microphones since around 1970 and at that time we were able to produce microphones with the same accuracy as wristwatches, which led to the development of the COS-11 series with a vertically arranged diaphragm, continuing from 1991. In connection with this, the COS-11 ultra-compact lavalier microphone with high sound quality and high performance was born in consideration of movie production and high-definition broadcasting.

Since then, we have continued to develop water-repellent specifications, digital wireless radio interference removal, and supple and strong cables.

During this period, we have maintained the high sound quality and durability that have been highly evaluated for more than 30 years.

We will continue to make further improvements in the future.
