Waiting times increased in 2023 as patient numbers increased (up by 20% from 2022) and we experienced staff shortages.

Our healthcare-associated infection incident rate dropped again due to the work of our infection prevention control and housekeeping teams, alongside all staff members' commitment to improving knowledge, adherence and behaviour change.

Seven doctors graduated from our three-year sub-specialty training programme in 2023. Each graduate is one of Cambodia's few intensive care, neonatal, oncology, surgery and respiratory specialists addressing gaps in care

"We just don't have enough neonatologists in Cambodia, in rural or urban areas. In rural areas, there are many critical cases requiring emergency intervention, but it's extra challenging with limited equipment and transportation. Delays mean life or death for newborns and their mothers.

Dr Say Sopheakneary AHC neonatologist I'll never forget the baby who was born less than one kilogram in a rural area in critical condition. After bringing them to AHC and weeks of specialised intensive neonatal care, the baby survived and is healthy today."



Our fundraising grew in 2023 for the first time since 2019. Thanks to our community of supporters near and far, international donations increased and contributions from the Cambodian community remained steady.


Launched in July 2022, our patient contribution system encourages families who can afford it to make a small contribution to the cost of their child's care. In 2023, families contributed to over US\$500,000. This helps ensure that we can continue providing free services to those unable to pay.

We're excited to continue developing alternative sources of income, and work with our community of supporters in Cambodia and around the world to keep AHC sustainable and our treatments accessible for all.






