

Status of collection of assessed contributions, including Member States in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution

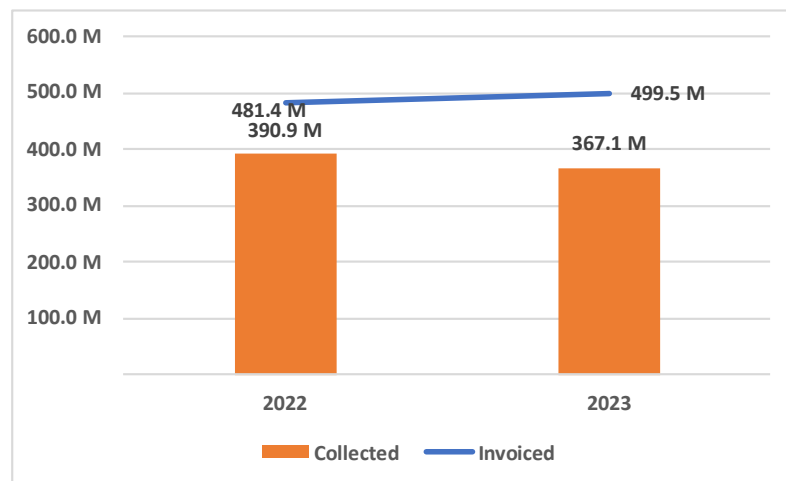
Report by the Director-General

STATUS OF COLLECTION

1. In order that WHO may deliver the approved programme budget, contributions from Member States must be received in full and on time. Under Financial Regulation 6.4, all Member States are required to pay their contribution as of 1 January of the year to which it relates.

2. Contributions for 2023 were received, either in full or in part, from 155 of the 197 Members and Associate Members (compared with 154 Members and Associate Members in 2022).¹ Details of amounts assessed and collected are shown in Annex 1. Collections for 2023 assessments amounted to US\$ 367.1 million or 73% of the total invoiced, a significant drop from 81% in 2022 (Fig. 1). Outstanding contributions for 2023 alone, converted at 31 December 2023 rate, amount to US\$ 140.0 million compared with US\$ 90.4 million of outstanding collections in 2022. Member States are urged to make timely payments of their annual contributions.

3. Unpaid contributions as at 31 December 2023 for current and previous financial periods amounted to US\$ 73.0 million and Sw.fr. 77.4 million (constituting a combined total of US\$ 165.7 million) with a further US\$ 22.6 million due under special arrangements authorized by the Health Assembly (compared with US\$ 122.9 million (combined total) and US\$ 26.3 million (due under special arrangements), respectively, at 31 December 2022). Details of payments made as at 31 December 2023 under special arrangements are shown in Annex 2.

MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED IN ADVANCE

4. As at 31 December 2023, some Members had made advance payments, either in full or in part, against their regular budget contributions for 2024 and future years. In total, contributions received in advance as at 31 December 2023 amounted to US\$ 57.4 million (US\$ 49.5 million at 31 December 2022). Advance payments are detailed in Annex 3.

MEMBERS IN ARREARS AND SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

5. Article 7 of the Constitution states that, if a Member fails to meet its financial obligations to the Organization, the Health Assembly may suspend the voting privileges to which a Member is entitled. If, at the time of the opening of the Health Assembly, a Member is in arrears in an amount that equals or exceeds the amount of contributions due from it for the preceding two full years, in accordance with resolution WHA41.7 (1988), the Health Assembly may decide to suspend the Member's voting privileges.

6. In accordance with previous Health Assembly resolutions, the voting privileges of the following 10 Member States continue to be suspended: Afghanistan, Central African Republic, Comoros, Dominica, Lebanon, Lesotho, Somalia, South Sudan, Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) and Yemen. Details of the amounts outstanding are provided in Annex 4. The suspension is to continue at the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly (in 2024) and subsequent Health Assemblies until the arrears have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

7. In accordance with resolution WHA76.10 (2023), if, by the time of the opening of the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Gabon, Sao Tome and Principe and Sierra Leone are still in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution, their voting privileges shall be suspended. Bolivia (Plurinational State of) has subsequently reduced to its arrears to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution. Unless payment is received before the opening of the Seventy-Seventh World Health Assembly, voting privileges for Gabon, Sao Tome and Principe and Sierra Leone will be suspended. The suspension will then continue at the Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly (in 2025) and subsequent Health Assemblies until the arrears have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

8. Annex 2 lists the seven Member States that currently have special arrangements for repayment of arrears approved previously by the Health Assembly. Payments amounting to US\$ 1.1 million were received from these Member States in 2023 in accordance with these special arrangements (compared with US\$ 1.3 million in 2022). Although two further Member States, Tajikistan and Ukraine, had opening balances at 1 January 2023 related to 2022 arrears, these were subsequently cleared in 2023 and the Member States therefore have no remaining balances. Two of the Member States listed in Annex 2 – Iran (Islamic Republic of) and Kyrgyzstan – have met their commitments under these arrangements. Five Member States, Afghanistan, Central African Republic, Somalia, Sudan and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of), did not meet their commitments in 2023. Voting privileges for

Afghanistan, Central African Republic, Somalia and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) were suspended under previous Health Assembly resolutions. Unless further payment is made by Sudan by the time of the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly, it will lose its voting privileges with effect from the opening of the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly (2024).

9. As at 8 April 2024, nine Member States, namely Belize, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Pakistan, Paraguay, Rwanda, Senegal and Suriname, were in arrears in the payment of their contributions in amounts that equal or exceed the amounts due from them for the preceding two full years, as listed in Annex 4. One Associate Member, Puerto Rico, was also behind with its assessed contributions.

10. Pursuant to resolution WHA41.7 (1988), unless there are exceptional circumstances justifying a different measure, the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly may wish to adopt a resolution deciding that the voting privileges of the nine Member States listed in paragraph 9 will be suspended as from the opening day of the Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly, if at that time the Member States concerned are still in arrears to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution.

11. In order to facilitate the payment of arrears, Member States may submit proposals to the Health Assembly for repaying such arrears over an extended period. Such proposals for special arrangements should be addressed in writing to the Director-General no later than 31 March and are then considered by the Programme, Budget and Administration Committee of the Executive Board, which subsequently makes its recommendations to the Health Assembly. No new proposals were submitted before the deadline for consideration in 2024.

ACTION BY THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY

12. No action is required by the Health Assembly in respect of those Members whose voting privileges have already been suspended under previous Health Assembly resolutions.

13. The Health Assembly may wish to consider the following draft resolution in respect of Belize, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Pakistan, Paraguay, Rwanda, Senegal and Suriname, in accordance with the principles stated in resolution WHA41.7 (1988):

The Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly,

Having considered the report on status of collection of assessed contributions, including Member States in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution,¹ and special arrangements for settlement of arrears;

Noting that, at the time of opening of the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly, the voting rights of Afghanistan, Central African Republic, Comoros, Dominica, Gabon, Lebanon, Lesotho, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) and Yemen were suspended, such suspension shall continue until the arrears of the Member States concerned have been reduced, at the present or future Health Assemblies, to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution;

Noting that Belize, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Pakistan, Paraguay, Rwanda, Senegal and Suriname were in arrears at the time of the opening of the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly to such an extent that it was necessary for the Health Assembly to consider, in accordance with Article 7 of the Constitution, whether the voting privileges of those countries should be suspended at the opening of the Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly in 2025,

DECIDES:

- (1) that, in accordance with the statement of principles set out in resolution WHA41.7 (1988), if, by the time of the opening of the Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly, Belize, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Pakistan, Paraguay, Rwanda, Senegal and Suriname are still in arrears in the payment of their contributions to an extent that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution, their voting privileges shall be suspended as from the said opening;
- (2) that any suspension that takes effect as set out in paragraph (1) above shall continue at the Seventy-seventh World Health Assembly and subsequent Health Assemblies, until the arrears have been reduced to a level below the amount that would justify invoking Article 7 of the Constitution;
- (3) that this decision shall be without prejudice to the right of any Member to request restoration of its voting privileges in accordance with Article 7 of the Constitution.
