Job Description

1. Position and number of instructors to be recruited

One Assistant Professor (tenure-track) at the Veterinary Teaching Hospital

2. Outline of the field and responsibilities

The faculty members of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital consist of one professor, one associate professor, and one assistant professor, who undertake both educational and research duties alongside veterinary clinical service at the Veterinary Teaching Hospital. This job announcement is to fill the position of Assistant Professor at the Veterinary Teaching Hospital in charge of Small Animal Surgery.

Major responsibilities include General Veterinary Surgery (shared), Veterinary Anesthesiology and Operative Surgery (shared), Veterinary Soft Tissue Surgery (shared), Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging (shared), Small Animal: Basic & Applied Practice in Veterinary Surgery (shared), Practice in Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging (shared), Hands-on Practice in Veterinary Clinic I-VI (shared), as well as all-university common education courses and specialized undergraduate basic courses (shared).

3. Qualifications

- (1) Possess integrity, insight, and enthusiasm for teaching and supervising undergraduate as well as graduate students.
- (2) Have willingness to contribute to the local community through Iwate University.
- (3) Hold a doctoral degree and have extensive knowledge and excellent research skills in veterinary surgery.
- (4) Hold a veterinary license in Japan.
- (5) Be able to actively participate in surgical services at the affiliated veterinary hospital.
- (6) Be able to communicate fluently in Japanese.
