The 1912 neo-Georgian building was originally known as the Thorne Mansion and now houses the Morristown Unitarian Fellowship. It is individually listed on the National and New Jersey Register of Historic Places. The building was designed by Aldrich and Delano, who also designed the U.S. Embassy in Paris and the South Portico of the White House.

The 2005 grant provided for the installation of a sprinkler system in the basement.

The 2006 grant assisted with the preparation of a Preservation Plan.

The 2007 grant was to provide for a roof replacement. However, the Fellowship had to decline this grant in January 2008.
